The Black Box is for all students who require a controlled environment to produce video, photography, and performance projects, in addition to students who need space to document artwork.

Access:

- Please email Genesis Salinas (genesis.salinas99@myhunter.cuny.edu) at least
 24 hours in advance to schedule time in the Black Box.
- At the time of your appointment, please go to the main office to pick up the key.

Policy Agreement:

 You will agree to pay all actual repair or actual replacement costs resulting from any harm, damage or loss of any nature whatsoever (including, but not limited to theft) to the equipment identified in the Policy Agreement while Black Box space is reserved in your name.

Rules:

- You are responsible for the safe handling of all equipment in the space when you make a reservation. PLEASE BE GENTLE, CALM, + PATIENT.
- DO NOT REMOVE EQUIPMENT FROM THE BLACK BOX. Everything in the room belongs to the room and is not for personal use outside of the black box or outside of the building.
- Please keep the equipment safe by locking the room when you leave to use the restroom or for any other reason.
- Dust is harmful to all photography and video equipment. Put all equipment back in any case/bag/box that it was originally in.
- Please keep the Black Box as organized as possible to keep our equipment in the best condition. You MUST clean up after yourself and leave the space in the same condition that you found it.
- Only use a piece of equipment for what it was intended for.
- Always ask for help when you are having a problem with a piece of equipment (if you feel unsure of how it operates, etc).
- Never try to fix anything yourself if you don't know how. Let staff know of these issues.

FYI Profoto D2 Air will get hot:

"The D2 monoblocs are equipped with a cooling fan which is intelligently controlled to more effectively manage operating temperatures according to the type of usage. When it's working hard it's quite noisy, but this will only happen if you work the D2 extremely hard and, the rest of the time, the fan is actually quite quiet."

The modeling lamp – a conventional QH source – can be set to maximum, proportional control or free adjustment.

To increase the life of your Profoto flash:

- Before you start using your flash connect the AC power to the unit and wait for 45 seconds to soft start the capacitors.
- Keep your working environment as dust clean as possible, the harder you work your Profoto flash the more the cooling fan will work resulting in more dust coming into the flash unit.
- Make sure that the product gets the best possible cooling. Make sure that the fan is working, and that the product is cleaned from dust so that the air flows This applies to both flash heads and generators.
- Turn off the modeling light when it's not needed.
